PUBLIC FORUM


Mayor Berry informed the Board of Aldermen that due to the fact that the City of Portageville does not own the Police Department Building and leases it from the Portageville Community Development Corporation, the City of Portageville cannot proceed grant funding for the roof; however, budget equipment for 2020 Fiscal year for the Street, Police and Fire Departments can utilize this grant in turn freeing up funds for the roof repair. Discussion followed. Mayor Berry asked for a motion to remove the roof from the loan application and add in the budgeted equipment list totaling \$140,216.00. Motion was made by Alderman Doering and seconded by Alderman James. Voting was as follows: Alderman James, yea; Alderman Doering, yea; Alderman Essary, nay. Motion passes 2 to 1.

Mayor Berry asked if there were any public regarding the USDA Loan Application. There were none.


Mayor Berry asked if there were any public comments regarding the codification project of the Portageville City Code. There were none.
