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# MINUTES

CITY COUNCIL MEETING Portageville City Hall June 4, 2020

CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the City of Portageville Board of Aldermen was held on Thursday, June 4, 2020, at City Hall, 301 E Main St. This meeting was postponed from Monday, June 1, 2020 due to there not being enough members for a quorum. Mayor Vince Berry called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Moved by Alderman Essary, seconded by Alderman James and unanimously carried, to approve the agenda as submitted.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES Reg. Mtg.- 5/7/20 Mid-Month Meeting- 5/18/20

Mayor Berry asked members of the Council if they had read a copy of the Minutes made available to them three days prior to the meeting. All answered in the affirmative.

Mayor Berry asked if there were any additions or deletions to the minutes. There were none.

## **DEPARTMENTAL REPORTS**

## **RONNIE ADAMS- CHIEF OF POLICE**

Turned in a written report for the month of May.

Adams approached the Board of Aldermen about purchasing riot equipment for the police department. Discussion followed. The issue was tabled until July 6, 2020 meeting.

#### GEORGE DELISLE- FIRE CHIEF

Turned in a written report for the month of May.

Delisle updated the Board of Alderman on the work that summer help has been doing. He also informed the Board that the Fire Department will be putting together a plan to pressure test hydrants this summer for our ISO rating. Discussion followed. Mayor Berry advised that this will cause rust to be stirred up in the water lines all over town. Extra rover will be purchased for citizens and a notice will be put out to citizens once a time frame for the testing has been established.

# PARK BOARD

Todd Higgs, Park Board President, gave a verbal report for the month of May. The bathrooms at Massey Field are near completion and have been updated so they are handicap accessible. Higgs informed the Board of Alderman that they had received five bids for repairing the tennis court in Meatte Park. They ranged from \$20,000 to \$40,000. At this time, it is the recommendation of the Park Board to withhold approximately \$20,000 of funding from this year and combine it with funding received the next fiscal year to repair the tennis courts in 2021. Discussion followed. Floyd Simmons expressed his disapproval with the recommendation to put the project off another year. Mayor Berry stated that the issue would be tabled until July 6, 2020 to see if the cost of repair one or two of the three courts would be more cost efficient in the long run.

Mayor Berry also stated that the Board of Alderman needed to start looking at bids for Roof Repair on the Red Building and Police Department. This issue was tabled until July 6, 2020.

### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING- SRO

Mayor Berry stated that he had met with Michael Allred, Superintendent of Portageville Schools, regarding the Memorandum of Understanding for the School Resource Officer for the upcoming 2020-2021 school year. Changes to the previous MOU include the following:

- Increase of pay for extracurricular activities to \$3000.00 (the school district will reimburse the City of Portageville \$2300.00 for the expense)
- Removing the DARE expense of \$2000.00 from the school district and adding it to the City of Portageville's responsibility

Discussion followed. Mayor Berry asked for a motion to approve the changes and accept the 2020-2021 Memorandum of Understanding. Motion was made by Alderman Essary and seconded by Alderman James. All members voted in favor.

# **EXTRA TRASH PICK UP POLICY**

Mayor Berry addressed concerns over extra trash pick up in the City of Portageville. Discussion followed. Tags will be purchased at City Hall in conjunction with an established price list. Motion was made by Alderman Essary and seconded by Alderman James. All members voted in favor.

Floyd Simmons addressed the Board of Alderman and with his thoughts over the tennis court situation. Simmons also asked about the use of the Vactor truck.
